



CAP Employer Partnership Levels of Participation

Community Partner

Community Partners work with the Clean Air Partnership to provide commuting options information to their member organizations, residents and other interested parties that make up a Community Partner's network. Community Partners are typically groups such as associations, chambers of commerce, nonprofit member organizations and neighborhood associations.

Bronze Partner

- Work with the Clean Air Partnership to customize your company's Clean Air Program.
- Designate a Clean Air Partnership Program coordinator at your worksite. This person will serve as the liaison between the Clean Air Partnership and employer management.
- Notify employees via fliers, intranet or e-mail of air quality action days.
- Meet all of the following requirements:
 - Implement an education program by distributing information regarding commuting options via e-mail, and by posting commuting options in common areas.
 - Encourage employees to share rides to work:
 - Promote the Regional Transportation Authority's Match Request Program by making applications available to employees.
 - or -
 - Host annual commuter events.

Benefits: Bronze award certificate, recognition in quarterly newsletter

Silver Partner

- Meet Bronze-level criteria.
- Outline your company's clean air plans for the year, and describe how those plans will be achieved. Submit the plan to the Clean Air Partnership.
- Meet at least three of the following requirements:
 - Provide preferential parking at the worksite for carpools and/or vanpools.
 - Sell transit passes on-site.
 - Support a walk/bike program through at least one of the following:
 - Walk challenges
 - Secured bike storage
 - Access to showers/lockers
 - Provide at least a one-time reward to employees for ridesharing.
 - Allow alternative work arrangements (formal or informal) through at least one of the following:
 - Telecommuting
 - Flex-time
 - Compressed workweeks
 - Staggered shift schedules

Benefits: Silver award plaque, your company's profile on our Web site, recognition at Clean Air Partnership events and seminars

Gold Partner

- Meet Bronze- and Silver-level criteria.
- Submit a participation report to the Clean Air Partnership. This report will include a description of your company's program, the level of employee participation, and the overall results of the project.
- Complete at least three of the following projects:
 - Provide ongoing parking subsidy to carpoolsers/vanpoolers.
 - Provide ongoing transit pass subsidies.
 - Provide ongoing vanpool subsidies.
 - Provide ongoing incentives to all employees using alternative transportation.
 - Implement a formalized telecommuting program.
 - Implement a formalized alternative work schedule program.

Benefits: Gold award trophy, use of the Clean Air Partnership's logo, your company's profile on our Web site, inclusion in quarterly news release and other media opportunities
